Those on the live stream may wish to use food items from home (crackers, bread, juice, water) to join in on the Communion.



IT DOESN'T ALL GO BACK INTO THE BOX



As the holidays conclude, we go through the process of putting the decorations back into storage. As often occurs, everything doesn't go back into the boxes. There are some things which we have forgotten, left out or thrown away. There are things that we've added too.

Many have had the experience where a new Christmas tree was purchased and the boxes look so nice, the sides are even. Reality strikes when putting the Christmas tree away, we discover it doesn't all go back in the box.

That Christmas tree that stood in the special place in your home had to be changed, arranged in order to make it more beautiful. And now that beauty is to be hidden away in a box in which it doesn't fit any longer.

It doesn't all go back in the box nor should it. I'm not talking about the Christmas tree. I'm talking about Christmas and the experience with Christ.

Allow me to use another illustration - that of a candle. A beautiful candle is received as a gift. You take it out of the box. You set it in an appropriate place and you light it. The candle provides light and gives off an aroma that fills the whole house. When the season is done, the candle is put back in the box and set aside in storage for next Christmas. But there is an essential part of that candle which cannot be put in the box - the light!

We have heard the words of scripture from the prophet Isaiah, "The people who walk in darkness will see a great light - a light that will shine on all who live in the land where death casts its shadow." {Isaiah 9:2} "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you." {Isaiah 60:1}

It all is not intended to go back into the box. Jesus said to a crowd one day: "You are the light of the world - like a city on a mountain, glowing in the night for all to see. Don't hide your light under a basket [or in a box]! Instead, put it on a stand and let it shine for all. {Matthew 5:14-15}

It doesn't all go back into the box, nor should it! Let your light shine. Your new encounter with Jesus this year - let it shine! Perhaps in 2024 because you don't pack away the light in a box but let it shine - will be exactly the dawning of new hope and life another may need to see.
