

A MARK OF SECOND CHANCES

Many people have wondered along the way about second chances. Some have taken advantage of second and third and fourth chances, opportunities that are provided for them in spite of past failures or even abandonments. Others will never seek a second chance. They have written themselves off or resolve that to try again is only to lead to failure again.

Since January through Easter, Pastor Ben and I are preaching from the Gospel of Mark. Mark is the shortest gospel yet it is full as it tells the good news of Jesus. Oftentimes the Gospel of Mark is looked at as Peter's gospel for the author, Mark, worked with Peter recording his messages, his stories, and his experiences with Jesus.

Peter referred to Mark as "my son." Peter is not the only apostle Mark had worked with. We read in the book of Acts that an individual by the name of Mark, also referred to as John Mark, was along on the missionary journey that Paul and Barnabas first took. In Acts 13 we read that John (John Mark) "left them to return to Jerusalem." In Acts 15 there is a pronounced disagreement between Paul and Barnabas to bring Mark along on another journey. Paul felt that Mark might abandon them again. Barnabas (whose name means "son of encouragement") thought it of great importance to bring Mark with them. Scripture records that Paul and Barnabas then parted ways on separate missionary journeys. Paul took with him Silas and Barnabas took with him Mark.

So what does this have to do with second chances? As we continue to read on through scripture, we find several statements about Mark that the apostle Paul writes in a couple of his letters. Colossians 4:10 - "My fellow prisoner Aristarchus sends you his greetings, as does *Mark*, the cousin of Barnabas. (You have received instructions about him; if he comes to you, welcome him.)" 2 Timothy 4:11, "Only Luke is with me. Get *Mark* and bring him with you, because he is helpful to me in my ministry."

The second chance comes when one who thought they had no value learns that they have been found to have great value. And that's a significant part of Easter! The Bible says: "You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. . . But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." {Romans 5:6,8}

The Gospel reveals to us that there is a second chance for all of us by trusting in Christ! This is the Good News! And Mark, who once abandoned the journey of proclaiming the Good News, received a second chance - recorded the Gospel as told by Peter, aided in the ministry of Timothy and Paul, and has touched billions of lives since.

We live because of the God of Second Chances! Happy Easter!
