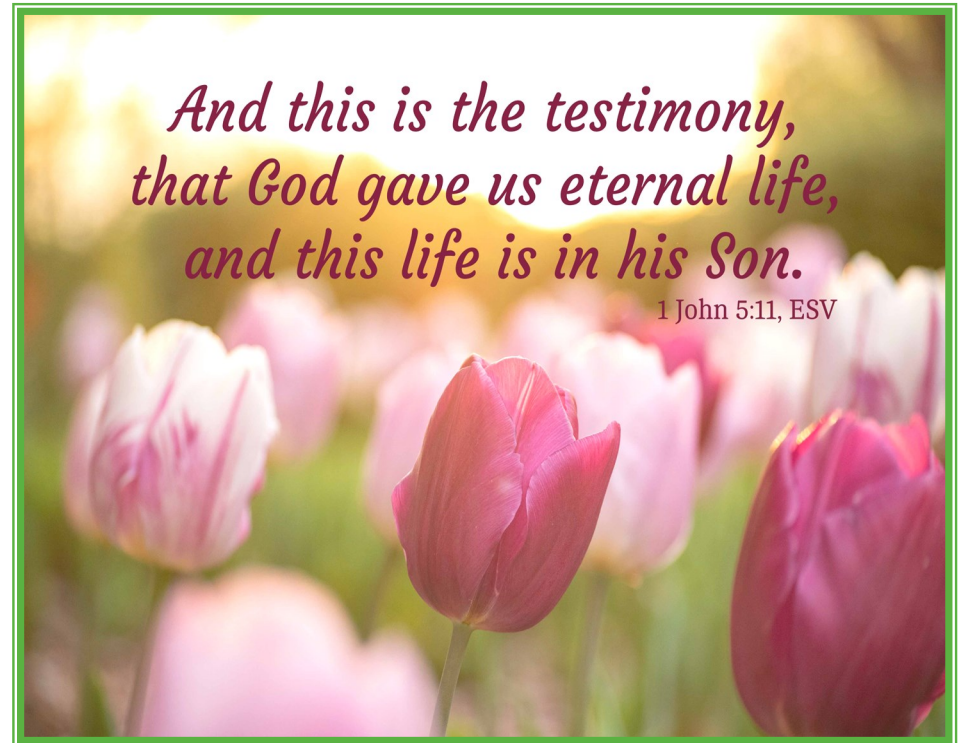




**Bruce & Betty Moses**
