We desire to be an encouragement to the residents of each home in providing for their wants. Funds are made available through investments and contributions to the fund by individuals, churches, and groups.



The former church building in Millertown was built in 1877. At sometime, either in the initial construction or during a project of addition in 1920-23 or 1932-38, the church bell was put into use. It sounded an invitation to 'Come and worship!' The last Sunday of worship in that bethel was held on Sunday, July 30, 1961. That day was the last Sunday the bell was formally used by the church, until today.

In the 60 years which have passed by, this bell was not far from 'home'. When the former building was being dismantled, the bell was sold to E. S. (Ted) Colborn of Mill Run for the sum of \$500.00. Mr. Colborn constructed a bell house for it, where it remained for 59 years until 2020. Upon learning the origin of the bell, the family of Wally and George Colborn returned the bell back to the church in the Summer of 2020, and also generously paid for its restoration.
