Dead or Asleep?

1 Cor. 15:1-2,12-23

Paul wants us to be firm in our belief in the resurrection of the dead: it is absolutely central to our faith as Christians. In this text he reviews the consequences of denying the resurrection of the dead, and he also affirms that Christ makes resurrection a guarantee.

Why do people deny the possibility of resurrection?

In vv. 12-19, Paul outlines a logical series of terrible consequences if resurrection isn't true.

Which of these awful consequences bothers you the most?


In vv. 20-23, Paul shares the GREAT news that Jesus was indeed raised. What are the implications of this?

For further study:

Read Luke 6:17-26. How does Jesus want us to live, based on the promise of future glory?

Read John 11:11-15. Why does Jesus say that Lazarus is "asleep" rather than "dead"? What does this mean for us?

Read 1 Thess. 4:13-18. Why is it that Christians don't grieve the death of loved ones the way the rest of the world does?
