Tested in the Wilderness

Luke 4:1-13

Jesus had his own 40 day Lenten experience at the beginning of his ministry. Filled by the Holy Spirit, he went into the solitude of the wilderness and was tempted by the devil three times, and we'll see how he continued to "reverse the curse" of Eden.

1. Stone into Bread (vv. 1-4)

- How does this compare to the temptation of Eve in Gen. 3:1-6?
- How does Satan tempt us in our weakness?
- What does Jesus teach us in his response?

2. Shortcut to Power (vv. 5-8)

- How are we tempted to take shortcuts to reach goals?
- What does Jesus teach us in his response?

3. Jumping into Prestige (vv. 9-12)

- Why would jumping off the temple be a temptation?
- What does Jesus teach us in his response?

Take it home:

- Identify those areas of your life where you know you're weak. This is your BATTLEFIELD!
- Memorize scripture verses that will help you do battle with the enemy.
- Trust the Lord to provide a way out, and get help from trusted Christian friends.
