## Luke 4:14-30

Last week we read of how Jesus battled the devil in the wilderness. Today we'll see Him battling HIS HOMETOWN when He goes home. It was a hot mess of a situation that got Him in a lot of trouble. We'll see why that happened, and what Jesus says to us today about our own hot mess.

## Jesus preaches at His home synagogue in Nazareth (vv. 16-27)


- In vv. 16-22, Jesus is invited to speak and reads from Isa. 61:1,2. What does He say about Himself?
