Invitation to Worship: Psalm 131

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 2:1-10

Message by Pastor Ben *“No Longer Dead!”*

### No Longer Dead! *Eph. 2:1-10*

Paul begins this chapter by reminding the Ephesian Christians of their  
life before they met Jesus, and then he reminds them of what Jesus  
has done for them and the life they live now. How do you describe the  
difference Jesus has made in your life?

**1. DEAD (vv. 1-3)**

- What do the terms “transgressions and sins” mean? How does Paul connect these to spiritual death?
- What does he mean by saying we were “objects of wrath”?

**2. MADE ALIVE (vv. 4-7)**

- How does God’s grace make our new life possible?
- What does it mean for us to be “seated [with Christ] in heavenly realms”?

**3. LIFE TODAY (vv. 8-10)**

- What role do we play in our salvation?
- Do you see yourself as a masterpiece? How does that affect your self-image?
- What are the works God has prepared for *you* to do as an expression of your salvation?

**TAKE IT HOME:**

1. Take time to remember what God has saved you from, and where you would be today if you hadn’t met Jesus.
2. If someone asked you, “How did you come to know Jesus?” – what would you say? Write down a short testimony of how you would respond, and pray for opportunities to share it with others.
3. You are God’s masterpiece, and He has prepared works for you to do. Pray about how God wants you to serve Him, and look for opportunities to bless others.
