

Are You a Member?

What's the point of being a member of the church? We hear that question every time we take in new members, which we're planning to do on Oct. 11 and 12. Joining the church doesn't earn points with God, as though you get a nicer upgrade in a heavenly mansion. Neither does it mean you get membership privileges, like a better parking spot or free Wi-Fi usage (which is free to anyone). So what's the point?

I'm glad you asked! Church membership actually begins when a person is born again through faith in Jesus Christ. "... *In Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others*" (Rom. 12:5). All Christians are members of the Church (notice the capital "C"), the Body of Christ. Membership in a local congregation is a bit like membership in a club with a MAJOR difference. Most clubs exist for the benefit of the members; churches exist for the benefit of the whole community or town. When a person joins the church (notice the little "c"), they're making vows of commitment to a local family of fellow brothers and sisters in Christ. They're joining *this* family. Here is the membership covenant:

"I, as a member of the Indian Head Church of God, do mutually and solemnly covenant and agree for the promotion of our spiritual welfare, the salvation of others, and the glory of God, to unite in Church fellowship, to live in Christian love and peace, and to walk and live according to the commandments and ordinances of God, as He has revealed the same to us in His Holy Scriptures. I believe these contain the only authoritative rule of Christian faith and practice. Moreover, I do solemnly promise

To submit to the order of God's House, that is to say, to the government and discipline of His Church.

To cheerfully obey the office-bearers, who are or at any time may be placed over us in the Lord, and

To cooperate with the church in her program of Christian service to this community and the world through my attendance, financial and spiritual support to the full extent of my ability."

Local church membership is about commitment. It's about a Christian saying, "This is my spiritual home; this is my spiritual family. God has called me to serve in this place at this time, as I offer my gifts, my resources, and my time." On October 11 and 12, we'll have the opportunity to celebrate as several of our brothers and sisters take their membership vows.
