“Baptized for Ministry”


Matthew 3:13-17

Epiphany begins with a focus on Jesus’ baptism and the launching of His public ministry. This is a spiritually profound event which should help us remember our own baptism. Think about your experience. What stands out in your memory of being baptized?

- Review Matt. 3:1-12. What does John the Baptizer say about Jesus? How will the baptism that He will give differ from that of John’s baptism?
- When Jesus approaches John to be baptized, how does John react? What are some reasons for his reluctance to do as Jesus asked?
- Jesus responds by saying, “It is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness.” What does He mean by this?
- What is the significance of the Holy Spirit appearing as a dove, and the voice from heaven?

TAKE IT HOME:

- How have you been cleansed by the water of baptism? How does your heart need cleansing today?
- How has the Holy Spirit empowered you to serve God? What new ministry assignment does God have for you?
