




MAKING A PRAYER REQUEST

"God is at Work – Open Your Eyes!"

John 4:27-42

Have you ever brought in a harvest? It can be hard work, and sometimes there's not much time to finish the job. Today's message is about opening our eyes to see the spiritual harvest Jesus wants us to bring in.

An awkward moment, and an unlikely evangelist (vv. 27-30)

- Why might the disciples feel awkward here?
- How does the Samaritan woman show the difference Jesus has made?

Jesus teaches His disciples (vv. 31-38)


- What food does Jesus have that the disciples don't know about?
- What does Jesus teach His disciples in the comparison with sowing and reaping?
- Why is opening our eyes so imperative?

The Samaritans believe (vv. 30-42)

- The Samaritans prove Jesus' lesson about the harvest being ready.
- Where role does the Samaritan woman play in reaching her neighbors?

TAKE IT HOME:

- What difference has Jesus made in your life? How does it affect your message to others?
- Think about our church's history. How do we stand on the shoulders of those who have gone before us? How will we continue that legacy for the future?
- What is the goal of sharing the message of Christ with others? Where do we fit in?
