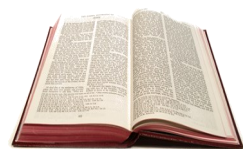

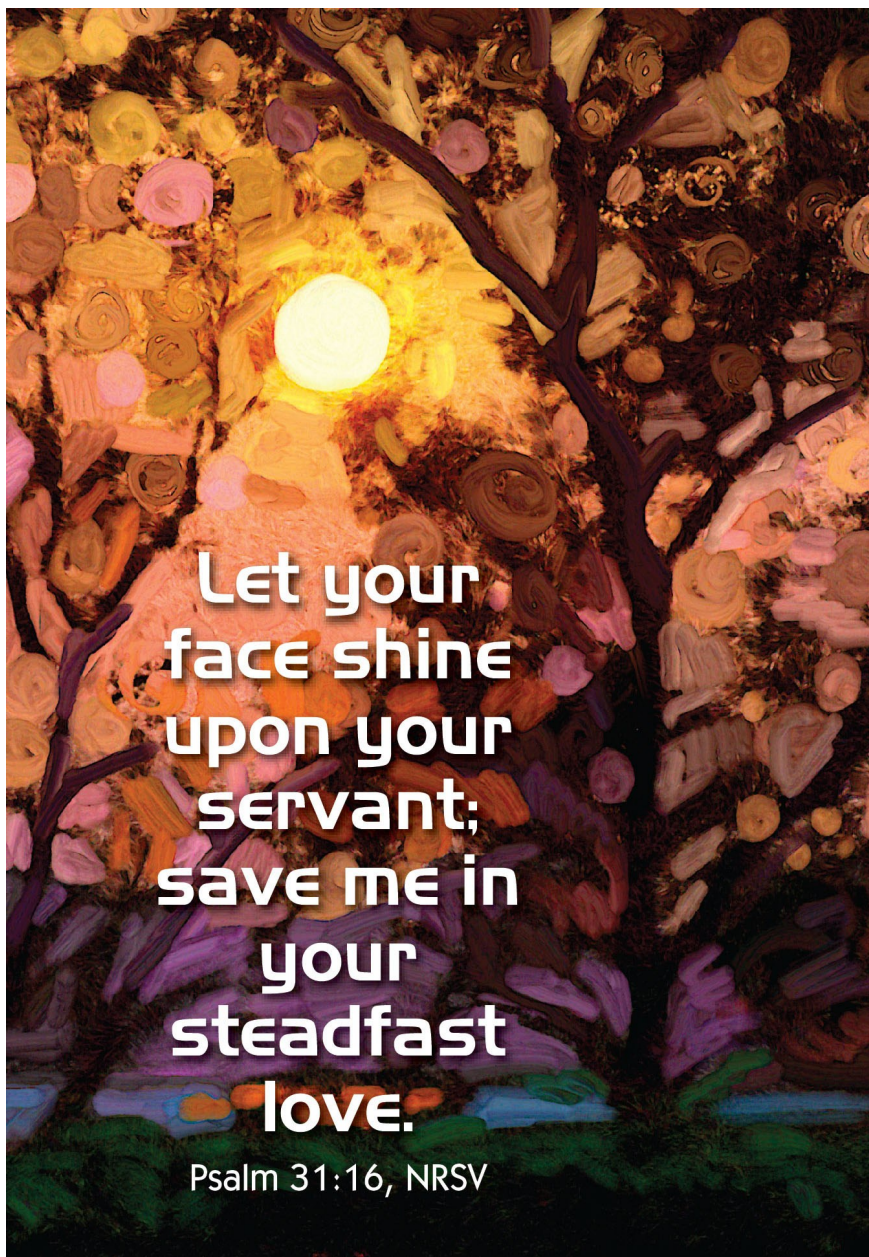
**INTERCESSOR PRAYER LIST**

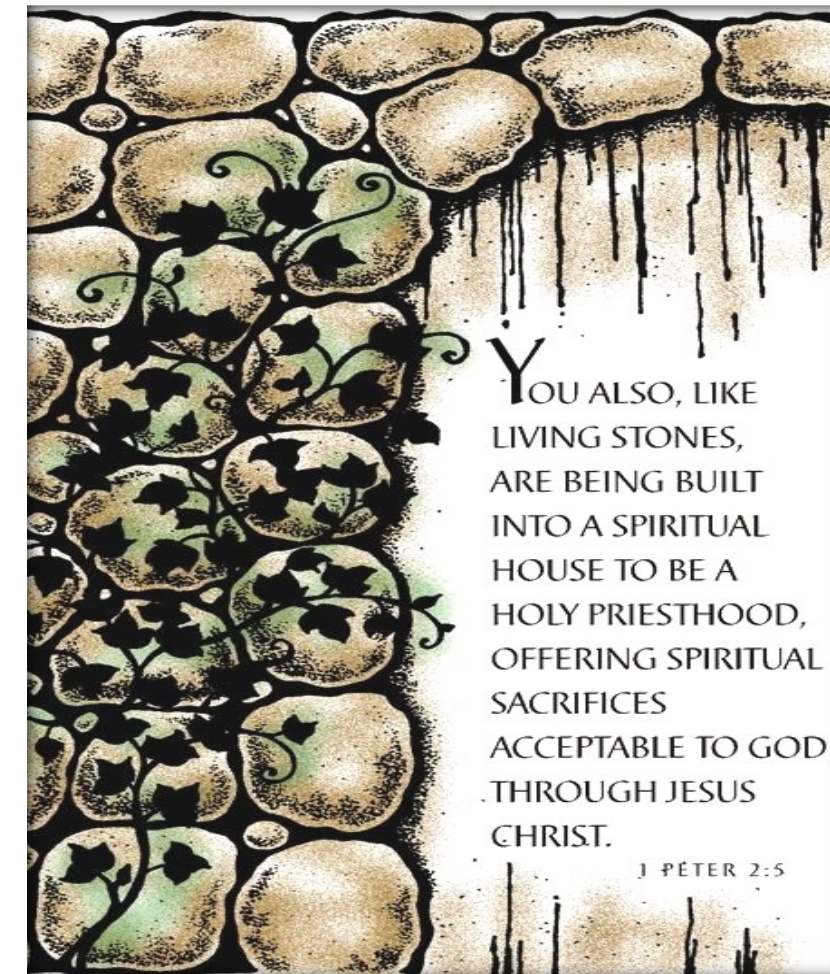
