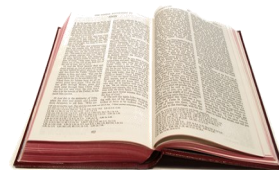

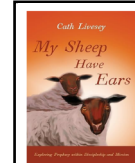

A Record-Breaking Love Romans 4:13-25

#1 A Great Faith - vss. 1-8

A great faith does not deny reality; it simply acknowledges that God is greater than reality.

*How can I exercise **a great faith** that breaks my record of self-reliance by trusting in our record-breaking God?*

#2 A Great Hope - (vss. 9-18)

Human hope is wishful thinking. Biblical hope is a confident expectation.

*How will I exercise **a great hope** that looks past the graveyard of my circumstances and sees the resurrection power of Christ?*

#3 A Great Love - (vss. 23-25)

God's love breaks the record of our debt and wipes the slate clean.

*How can I exercise **a great love** for God who has shown to me a record-breaking love?*

Take it home

God's record-breaking love is received by faith, acted upon with hope, and lived out in love to God.
