- *The locks on all outside doors need to be updated.

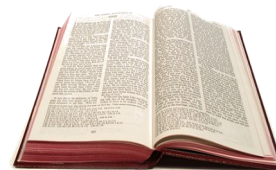

Paper Towel Tubes are needed for VBS. They can be put in one of the bins in the Indian Head side foyer.



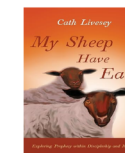

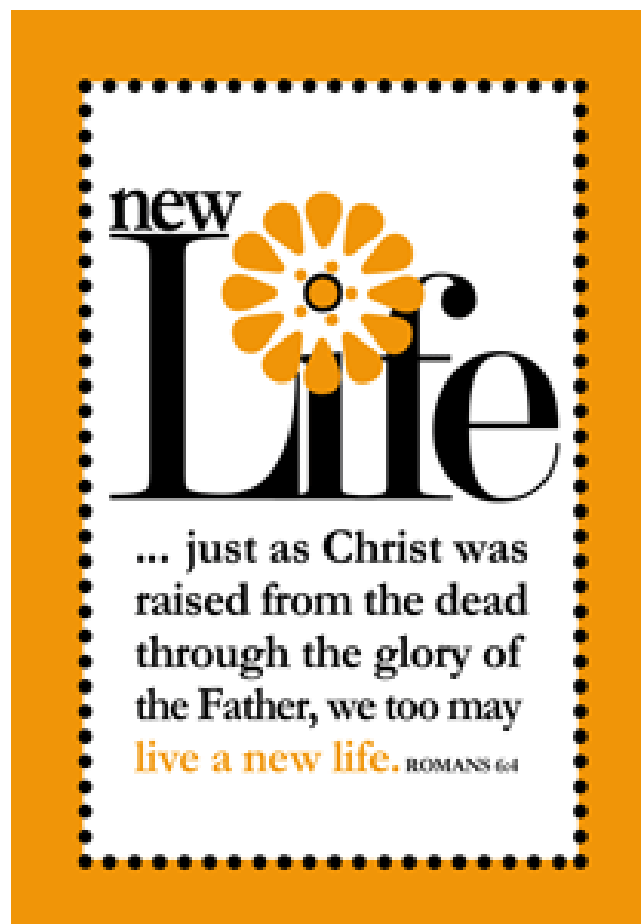
INTERCESSOR PRAYER LIST

Invitation to Worship: Psalm 89:1-2, 14-17

Scripture Reading: Romans 6:12-23

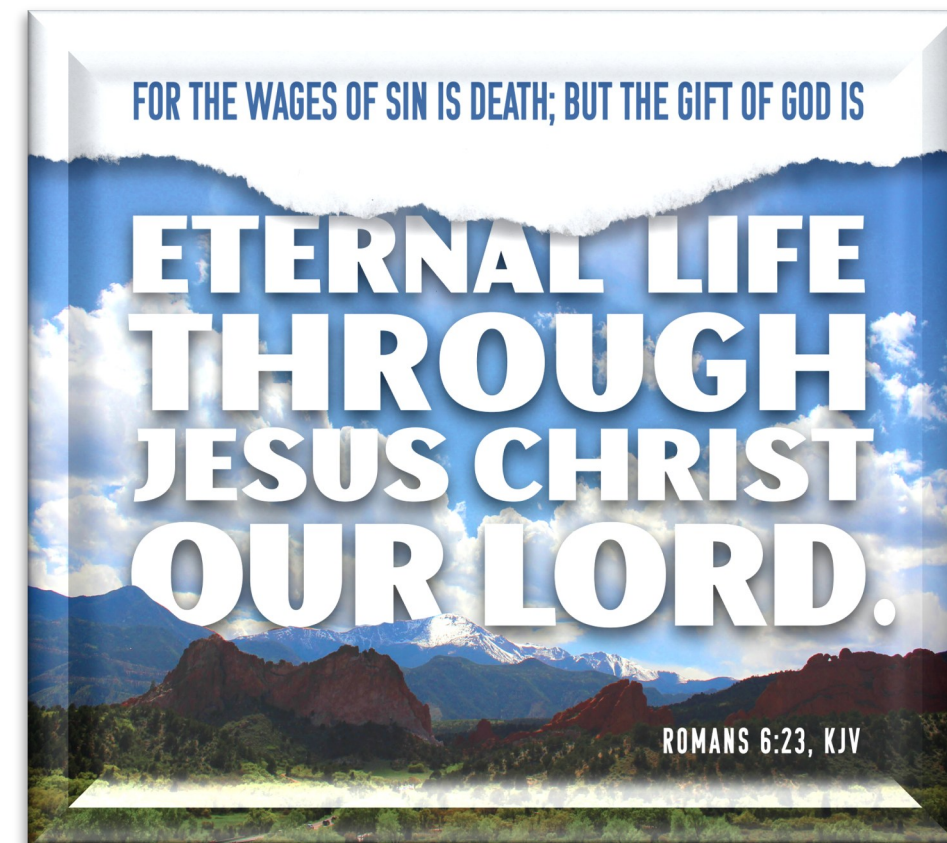
Message by Pastor Ben Tobias

"Consecrated"

Romans 6:12-23

Paul continues his emphasis on living "under new management" in Rom. 6:12-23. Here we'll see how we are to live in a radically different way with a very different goal.

- The New Way to Live (Verses 12-14)
 - How does v. 12 naturally follow from v. 11? (What is "therefore" there for?)
 - Think of all the different parts of your life: your body, your schedule, your finances, etc. Which parts are difficult for you to dedicate to God?
 - Grace vs. Law: What does it mean to be "under grace" rather than the law?
 - Who's in charge? (Verses 15-19)
 - Why is it impossible to serve both masters?
 - How does heart obedience differ from legalism?
 - How does Paul use the imagery of our past slavery to sin to challenge us to be equally devoted "slaves to righteousness"?
 - Different Outcomes (Verses 20-23)
 - Paul asks what benefit the Romans got from the things they are now ashamed of (v. 21). What are the hidden costs of sin during this life?
 - The Ultimate Wage: Verse 23 says "the wages of sin is death." How does the concept of a "wage" imply we are getting exactly what we earned?
 - The Free Gift: Compare "wages" to the "free gift" of eternal life. How does God's grace in Christ Jesus shift the focus entirely from our performance to His sacrifice?
- Take it home:**
- Do a "self-inventory": What parts of your need to be consecrated to the Lord?
 - How can you focus on heart obedience rather than legalism?
 - Consider the outcomes of your choices. Are you being brought closer to God or further away?
