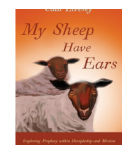
The WCSC ladies will be going on an outing, Thursday, July 23. and leaving the parking lot at 10:00 a.m. Contact Becky Dix for more information.

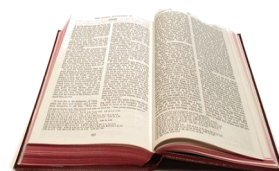
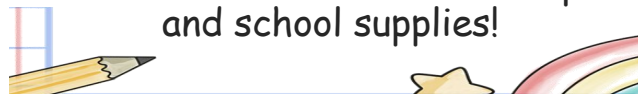

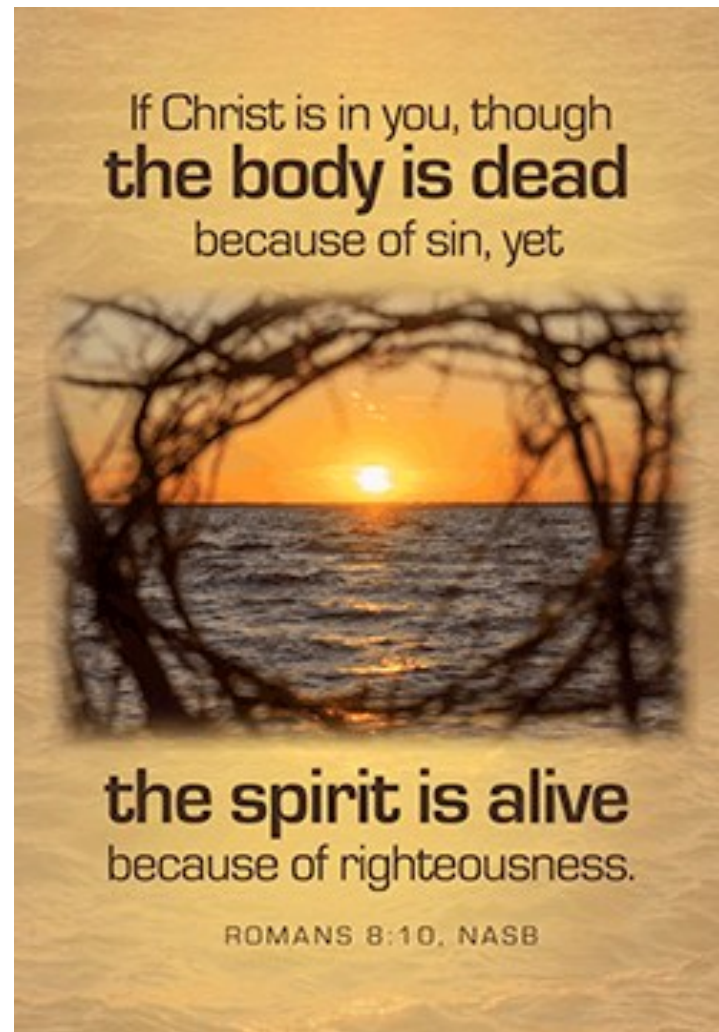
INTERCESSOR PRAYER LIST

Message by Pastor Ben Tobias

"Two Minds, Two Roads"

Romans 8:1-11

Throughout his letter to the Romans, Paul continually contrasts sin and grace, death and life. Chapter 8 is his triumphant declaration of what God has done to resolve the tragedy of humanity's rebellion.

No Condemnation (vv. 1-4)

- What condemnation is Paul talking about in v. 1?
- How is it that there can be "no condemnation"?
- What was God's solution?

Two Minds, Two Road (vv. 5-8)

- How does Paul contrast those who live according to the sinful nature with those who live according to the Spirit?
Minds set on: _____ (sinful) vs. _____ (Spirit)
Mind is: _____ (sinful) vs. _____ (Spirit)
- How else does Paul describe the sinful mind?

The Life of the Spirit (vv. 9-11)

- What happens to those in whom the Spirit dwells?
- Is it possible for a Christian to NOT have the Holy Spirit? Why or why not?
- How does Paul describe the power of the Holy Spirit here?

Take it home:

- When your conscience attacks you, repeat v. 1, thanking God for your pardon.
- When you're struggling with temptation, remind yourself of the Spirit's presence.
- Pray for those who are still condemned.
