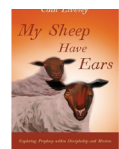

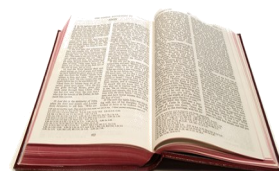
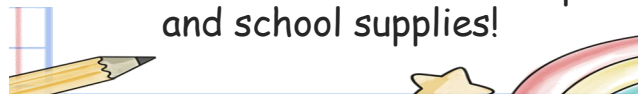

Romans 4:13-25

#1 A Great Faith – vss. 1–8

A great faith does not deny reality;
it simply acknowledges that God is greater than reality.

How can I exercise a great faith that breaks my record of self-reliance by trusting in our record-breaking God?

2 A Great Hope – (vss.9–18)

Human hope is wishful thinking. Biblical hope is a confident expectation.

#3 A Great Love – (vss. 23–25)

God's love breaks the record of our debt and wipes the slate clean.

How can I exercise a great love for God who has shown to me a record-breaking love?

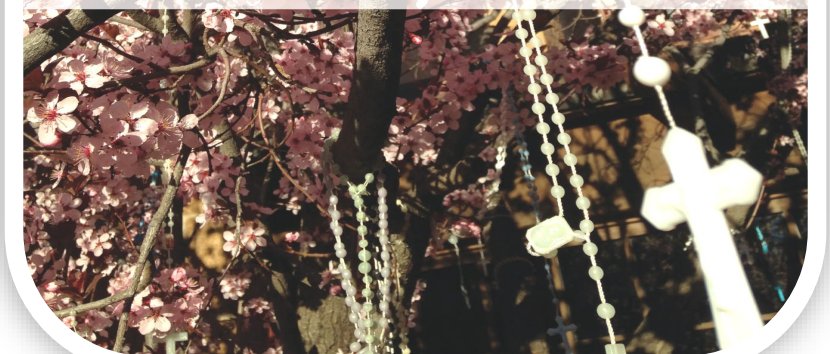
