Scripture Reading: Romans 8:31-39

Message by Pastor Ben Tobias

"No Separation"

Romans 8:31-39

Paul concludes chapter 8 with a stunning basis for confidence in life. We live in a world that beats us up and makes us think that the odds are against us. Sometimes we might be tempted to think that God Himself is against us. If you feel this way, listen to what Paul says here.

Five Verses, Six Questions (vv. 31-35)

- "What shall we say in response to these things?"
- "If God is for us, who can be against us?"
- "How will He not also graciously give us all things?"
- "Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen?"
- "Who then is the one who condemns?"
- "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?"

Question 6 is answered (vv. 37-39)

Nothing and no one shall separate us from the love of Jesus Christ!

- What does it mean to be "more than conquerors"?
- What is Paul convinced of?

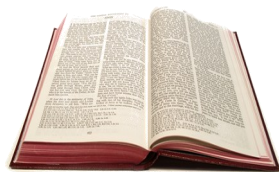
