Use your gifts! (vv. 6-8)

- What spiritual gifts has God given to you?
- How will you use them?

Take it Home:

- Do a daily self-assessment: Who do you see in the mirror?
- Explore your gifts and find opportunities to use them.

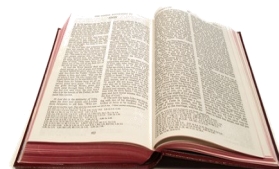

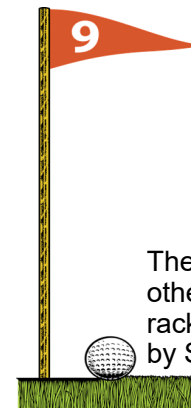
